

- Use `\interleave` for explanatory statements in the middle of an `align*` environment.
- Use `align*`, rather than successive `\[ ... \]`
- When adopting another proof:
  - Make sure you understand the original proof completely.
  - If some steps in the original are unnecessary in the adaptation, omit them.
  - If the adaptation needs more steps, add them.
- If you are using a theorem, make sure you are using it correctly
  - Check the implication  $\Rightarrow$  in the right direction.
  - Check the hypotheses of the theorem are satisfied.
- Use `\label` `\ref` system where appropriate.
